Seminar on “Industry Requirements in VLSI Domain”

The resource person explained the importance of strong fundamentals in digital electronics, Verilog/VHDL, and semiconductor concepts.

Students were also introduced to various EDA tools and industry practices used in VLSI design and development. The speaker highlighted the need for continuous learning, internships, and practical exposure to meet industry expectations.

The seminar was informative and helped students understand the technical competencies and professional skills required in the VLSI domain, motivating them to prepare for careers in the semiconductor industry.

National Institute of Amateur Radio (NIAR) Hyderabad
